NGAA AMOKURA (Head Students - Year 12 applicants only) - 4 positions:

From the applications for leadership positions, a "short list" of 6 - 8 will be identified and offered the opportunity to interview for the positions of Amokura (Head student). Following the interviews the appointment of two male and two female Amokura will be made.

The role of the Amokura:

- 1. To represent the school in the community, at particular events and functions.
- 2. To lead a Kaunihera Aakonga each, working alongside the BOT Student Representative, Amokura Maaori, and Amokura Pasifika. This work involved arranging and chairing meetings, reporting the outcomes of meetings to the school, and to take a leadership role in Kaunihera Aakonga (student council) projects.
- 3. To fulfil student leadership roles such as in assemblies, achievement celebrations, inter-school exchanges, and other similar occasions that may arise.
- 4. To assist in the co-ordination of arrangements for other significant events including the school ball and the Year 13 leavers event.

NGAA KAIAARAHI KAUNIHERA (Council Leaders) – 20+ positions:

The main role of these leadership positions is to lead ngaa Kaunihera Aakonga (student councils) and assist in the co-ordination of arrangements for Kaunihera Aakonga projects and events.

The SEVEN ngaa Kaunihera Aakonga (student councils) are:

AKORANGA – Learning Council MAAORI HAAKINAKINA – Sports Council PASIFIKA

HAPORI WHAANUI – Community Council TOI ME AHUREA – Arts and Culture Council

HAUORA – Well-Being Council

Current **Year 11 and Year 12** aakonga (students) have the opportunity to apply for Kaiaarahi Kaunihera roles.

Each of ngaa Kaunihera Aakonga (Students Councils) will be led by our Amokura, BOT Representative, Amokura Maaori (2) and Amokura Pasifika (2), and supported by FIVE Kaiaarahi Kaunihera.

Additionally, there will be leadership opportunities for Year 10 aakonga – TWO per Kaunihera Aakonga. Each te Kaunihera Aakonga will have TWO Year 10 aakonga.

NGAA KAITAUTOKO TUAKANA (Peer support leaders):

Current **Year 11 and Year 12** aakonga will also have the opportunity to apply for a Kaitautoko Tuakana role. These aakonga will be responsible for the peer mentoring and induction of new Year 9 aakonga entering our school. A programme of induction and mentoring will be established and training will be provided for Kaitautoko Tuakana to be able implement this programme with Year 9 aakonga. Kaitautoko Tuakana will also be supported (including training) by a Teacher in charge.
