

PHS Student Code of Expectations for all Sporting Games/Trips

As this is a school team or trip, the welfare and behaviour of all those involved comes under the jurisdiction of Pukekohe High School. This applies when competitors are at competitions and when they are at school.

Each student is attending this event as a representative of Pukekohe High School. Hence, your behaviour must reflect the fact that you are an ambassador of the school. You are expected to display the values of Pukekohe High School and not bring the school into disrepute.

This means you must adhere to the following points of the **Code of Expectations** for the above event/s:

- Cooperate with all instructions of supervising staff.
- Obey the law.
- > Follow all safety procedures carefully.
- Follow the Pukekohe High School Player's Fair Play Agreement.
- Follow the guidelines/rules/expectations of the sporting event
- Behave in a mature and appropriate manner.
- > Do not use cigarettes, drugs, or alcohol.
- > Treat others with respect.
- Wear the correct uniform as advised by the Sports Department or your coach.

You must also do the following at school:

- > Attend all classes at school.
- > Hand in all assessments and course work.
- > Represent our school to the best of your ability.

Fair Play Agreement

- Always play by the rules.
- Let my coach or team captain handle disputes and respect the decisions of officials without gesture or argument.
- Treat opponents with respect. Win with Humility. Lose with Dignity.
- Show appreciation for food play by both my teammates and my opponents.
- ➤ Always control my temper and exercise self-control.
- > Always play hard but fairly.
- > Remember that I am playing because I enjoy the sport and work at achieving my personal best.

Should you not fulfil the clauses in this Code of Expectations, there are several possible disciplinary consequences that your Team Management may choose to apply. These range from being stood down from a competition for a minor infringement to being sent home immediately at your parents'/caregivers' expense for a major infringement.
