Mathematics / Science - compulsory all year for Year 11s in 2023

In Year 13 - choose 5 options (5 subjects)in 2023

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National Certificate in Educational Achievement (NCEA)

Level 1 – usually Year 11

Need 80 Level 1 credits

- •10 of these need to be literacy credits
- •10 of these need to be numeracy credits



National Certificate in Educational Achievement (NCEA)

Level 2 – usually Year 12

•60 credits at Level 2 or above +

20 credits from any level



National Certificate in Educational Achievement (NCEA)

Level 3 – usually Year 13

•60 credits at Level 3 or above +

•20 credits from Level 2 or above



Endorsement

- Level 1, 2, or 3 Certificate Endorsement
- 50 credits at either Merit or Excellence Level
