



COURSE SELECTION 2023 - 2024 CHOOSING SUBJECTS FOR YEARS 11 – 13 in 2024


In Term 3 we will be starting the **Course Selection Process** for current Year 9 – 12 students. You will be making these decisions based on conversations with your Kaiaawhina, subject teachers and parents/whaanau about your desired future pathway. The information provided by learning areas includes subject content and Learning Progression Guidelines, which indicate the achievement that is an ideal level to have reached to cope with the work at the next NCEA level. The Course Selection process will be completed by everyone using **SchoolPoint**.

STEP 1: LOGIN TO SCHOOLPOINT

Login to **SchoolPoint** through your School Microsoft account by using your Student ID and password.



Once you are logged in, click on **SchoolPoint** from the dashboard.



You can also download the **SchoolPoint** app onto a phone from the App/Googlestores if you want. It will let you do all of the same things. Once downloaded, enter your Microsoft account username and password to login.



NOTE: Parents/ Caregivers are able to access KAMAR via the Parent Portal to VIEW (only) their student's selected subjects, however, we encourage our Parents/ Caregivers to sit with their student on their student's profile to support Course Selection.

STEP 2: PATHWAY PLANNING

At the beginning of Term 3 you should begin **Pathway Planning** using **SchoolPoint** with your Kaiaawhina during Whaanau Roopuu time. It is important that you have an idea of what sort of future pathway you want, and what you will need to do in order to achieve that.

Once you are logged into **SchoolPoint** select **Careers**



Then, use the dropdown options in the Careers section to complete all of the pathway planning questions and activities. This is a good time to think about all of your strengths, skills and interests.



Use these tools to help you think carefully about all the career options that you might be interested in. Your parents/guardians will also be able to login to **SchoolPoint** through the parent portal and see your answers, because whaanau are an important part of this planning process. Your Kaiaawhina will also receive an update of your answers, so that they can support you to select subjects which will help you be successful on your chosen pathway.

STEP 3: UNDERSTANDING WHAT I NEED TO SELECT (Years 11 - 13 in 2024)


SchoolPoint will only let you select subjects which you are able to take in your year level and will show you all your options. If two subjects are not able to be taken together (for example if they include the same Achievement Standards), then **SchoolPoint** will let you know. By selecting the compulsory subjects in Year 11, you will automatically be entered in enough literacy/numeracy credits to achieve NCEA Level 1.

NOTE: If you are Year 12 going into Year 13 in 2024, you must first set your Leaving intentions to “Returning” (first screen you see when logging into SchoolPoint) before you can start selecting subjects.

STEP 4: SELECTING YOUR SUBJECTS

1. View the subjects on offer




Select from the left-hand menu the following:

- **Learning Areas** – will bring up a button view of all learning areas
- **Overview and Search Courses** – will bring up a list of all courses in learning areas and a search bar
- **Recommended courses** – courses you are eligible to take based on your year level and subject combination restrictions
- **Favourite courses** – you can ‘favourite’ a subject you might want to take to view later, and it will be stored here
- **My Selected Courses** – this will show what you have selected for the following year

NOTE: If you are in Year 12 this year, you must have completed the leaving intentions section before you will be able to select subjects.

2. Select a subject

Go to “My Selected Course”, then select either option “Learning Areas” or “Courses for Me”. Select a course.



You must select any compulsory courses **first** before you can choose an option course.

To select a particular subject, click on **+ Select as one of my Courses**

****NOTE:** For students selecting MIT Trades Academy - as it is in addition to your set number of courses for the year, your backup choice will become one of your actual course selections. Your kaitiaki will have a conversation with you to select a backup/reserve course.

What if it says I'm not eligible for a subject?

Sometimes, you may not have taken the recommended prior classes to be automatically eligible for a subject. However, there may be a reason why this is still a subject that you believe you need for your future pathway, or a reason why you believe you should be considered for the subject. If this is the case, you may apply for an exemption, and give a reason why. This will then be considered by the school to decide if this is a suitable subject for you.



If the numbers are positive eg **2**: you have not selected enough courses, select “Courses for Me” and select the required amount of courses and backups.

If the number says **-1**: you have too many course lines, you would have received a warning while selecting, you will now need to correct this before being able to complete your selection.

To correct this you will need to remove a course by clicking on “Remove” and then “Confirm” in the next popup.
